Brush Cutting and Trimming at Block Wall, Adjacent to Hillsborough Ave.

The Special Taxation District, The Cove at Bay Port Colony, is requesting quotations from select firms to undertake brush cutting along approximately 2750 feet of block wall that is adjacent to the north side of Hillsborough Avenue near the intersection with Longboat Ave. The Scope of Services is as follows:

The selected firm is to do the following:

- 1) Cut and remove all trees, brush and branches which are less than or equal to four (4) inches in diameter, and selected larger trees that are marked with orange paint for removal, which are within four (4) feet of the top and back of the full length of block wall
The back of the wall is to be addressed without working from the ground, unless the selected firm acquires approval from adjacent property owner. ② ③ ④ ⑤ ⑥
- 2) Cut and remove ALL trees (except Palm in item 2.a), brush and branches Behind the two large signs (adjacent to the Longboat entrance) to the private property fences that separates the Housing Development called "The Cove at Bay Port Colony" from Hillsborough Avenue:
 - a) On WEST side: Clear ALL behind to AND around the Palm tree, at 1st bump out, to the property owners' fences. > Do NOT cut the Palm tree down. <
 - b) On EAST side: Clear ALL behind to the property owners' fences, to where the block wall begins

All exposed stumps are to be treated with Fertilome Brush and Stump killer (You may provide an equivalent to be submitted with response to RFP, along with supporting justification). ~~All exposed branch ends are to be sealed with an approved tree branch sealer (Brand to be submitted with response to RFP).~~

All removed material is to be transported and disposed of in accordance with all local laws, rules, and policies

The selected firm must be licensed to work in Hillsborough County, have at least \$1,000,000 liability insurance and have full Workers Compensation Coverage. All work must be completed within 60 days of execution of a signed agreement. (7)

④ ON WEST WALL 3 PALM TREES HAVE LIMBS FROM BRKING WALL GROWING INTO THEM, ONE JUST WEST OF UNKNOWN TREE GROWING IN FRONT OF WALL, NEXT FURTHER WEST AT LIGHT POLE B 1 21, NEXT AT RIGHT POLE B 1 19 MIMOSA IN PALM.

⑤ INSIDE SIGN WALL THERE IS A PALM GROWING FROM BOTTOM OF OPENING. CUT OFF AND LIFT OUT TOP OF TREE SO THAT REMAINING TRUNK NOT VISIBLE.

⑥ TWO PALMS IN FRONT OF SIGN WALL TO BE REMOVED.

⑦ SELECTED FIRM RESPONSIBLE FOR DAMAGE TO IRRIGATION SYSTEM
